
- Banapuram is a village In Khammam district.

Impact of intervention


- Children's curiosity and confidence has increased tremendously due to which they explore more and new opportunities open up.

Over a six year period, gender parity was achieved in school enrolments




Girls & Boys Enrolment in Higher Education (2009 to 2017)




Enrolment in higher Education tremendously increased boys as well as girls.

No of mothers who got married at this age

Most of the mothers of the students were married in their mid to late teens. while a small number were even married in their early teens.Only a miniscule number remained unmarried beyond 20. Since 2009, only three girls got married immediately after completing 10th class. The average age at marriage has risen to 19.



Average age of marriage National, State and Banapuram village




Only 3 students have got married after completing their 10th class since 2009. Most have gone on to pursue higher education.




Fathers' Education level
